RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OXNARD COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION ADOPTING A PRELIMINARY DRAFT RECOGNIZED OBLIGATION PAYMENT SCHEDULE

THE CITY OF OXNARD COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION HEREBY FINDS, DETERMINES, RESOLVES AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill x1 26 ("AB 26") and AB x1 27 ("AB 27") were passed by the State Legislature on June 15, 2011 and signed by the Governor on June 28, 2011; and

WHEREAS, among other things, AB 26 amends Sections 33500, 33501, 33607.5 and 33607.7 of the California Health and Safety Code and adds Part 1.8 and Part 1.85 to the California Health and Safety Code; and

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2011, the California Supreme Court granted a stay to prevent the operation of AB 26 and AB 27 (the "Stay"), except for a specified portion of Part 1.8 of the California Health and Safety Code (California Health & Safety Code §§ 34161-34167); and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2011, the California Supreme Court modified the Stay to exclude from the stay all of Part 1.8 of the California Health and Safety Code (California Health & Safety Code §§ 34161-34169.5) and California Health & Safety Code Section 34194(b)(2) (the "Modified Stay"); and

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code Section 34169(h) of AB 26 provides that a redevelopment agency must prepare a Preliminary Draft Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (the "ROPS") on or before September 30, 2011 pursuant to Section 34169(h) of AB 26 and

WHEREAS, the Preliminary Draft ROPS identifies each enforceable obligation on which payments will be required during the period of January 1, 2012 through June 30, 2012 and identifies the minimum payment amounts and due dates of payments required by each such enforceable obligation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Oxnard Community Development Commission resolves:

Section 1. The Commission hereby finds and determines that the foregoing recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. Without waiving its rights under AB 27 or the Modified Stay, or any of its objections that certain or all of the provisions of AB 26 and/or AB 27 violate the State Constitution and other laws and are invalid and unenforceable, the Oxnard Community Development Commission (the "Commission") desires to adopt the Preliminary Draft ROPS attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference in order to preserve its rights to make payments pursuant thereto.

Section 3. All other legal prerequisites to the adoption of this Resolution have occurred.

Section 4. The attached Preliminary Draft ROPS is hereby adopted.

Section 5. The Commission's Executive Director, or designee, is hereby authorized to take such actions as are necessary and appropriate to comply with AB 26 and the Modified Stay.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Section 7. The Commission' Secretary Designate shall certify as to the adoption of this resolution.
