U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
Fiscal Year 2016-17 Entitlement Grants

The City of Oxnard **estimates** that it will receive the following amounts from HUD for FY 2016-17:

Community Development Block Grant	\$2,131,803
HOME Investment Partnerships Act	\$561,174
Emergency Solutions Grant	\$191,219

When the City receives notifications from HUD with the actual allocations, adjustments to the amounts will be made.

The **mandatory** pre-application workshop sessions will be held on January 19, 2016 and January 21, 2016 at the Oxnard Main Library, Room B located at 251 south A Street in Oxnard. On each day of the workshops the program guidelines and application instructions for each grant will be presented as follows:

- From 9:00 AM to 11:30 AM: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)**
- From 1:30 PM to 3:00 PM: HOME Investment Partnerships Act (HOME)**
- From 3:30 PM to 5:00 PM: Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG)**

CDBG funds may be used for public facility improvements, urban infrastructure, housing, economic development programs, and public services (up to 15% of the entitlement amount).

HOME funds may be used for such activities as: the construction of new affordable housing units; rehabilitation of existing housing units; homebuyer assistance programs; land acquisition for new housing construction; development fees; and, limited rental assistance.

ESG funds may be used for: street outreach to homeless individuals and families; emergency shelter (up to 60% of the entitlement amount), homeless prevention and rapid rehousing assistance; and the homeless management information system.

Applications must be submitted absolutely no later than noon on Friday, February 19, 2016 to:
