Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible to apply?

- ⇒ Ventura County residents,
- ⇒ Who are 65 years and older

What is the reimbursement rate?

- ⇒ \$0.35/mile up to 100 miles/month for In-County trips
- ⇒ Out-of-County up to 300 miles/month (Medical ONLY)

What type of trips are eligible for mileage reimbursement?

- ⇒ In-County trip types can include medical and/or general trips
- ⇒ Out-of-County: medical only and requires verification

Can I still drive and be eligible as a rider?

- ⇒ Yes. Example: If you drive, but are limited to local or day-time driving, you can apply for all other trips that someone else drives you.

How is the mileage reimbursement program funded?

- ⇒ Ventura County Transportation Commission (VCTC) awarded a local non-profit Mobility Management Partners (MMP) a two-year grant.
