**LANE CLOSURES DELAYED**

**Oxnard, California.** Lane closures on Oxnard Boulevard has been extended to July 6, 2017, due to sewer pipe repair. After several failures along the Central Trunk Sewer line, the City of Oxnard continues to proactively identify aging sewer infrastructure that needs immediate repair.

City contractors began repairing a pipeline on Oxnard Boulevard between Date St. and Statham Boulevard. Construction is anticipated to continue through July 6, 2017.

Construction work takes place during the day from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm. Traffic control measures will be in place 24 hours, 7 days a week to protect the construction area.

Message boards have been set up along Oxnard Boulevard in an effort to notify the motoring public of the construction activities, including the expected completion date.
