BACKGROUND: Ormond Beach is considered by wetland experts to be one of the most important wetland restoration opportunity in southern California. Unlike other coastal wetland restoration projects in southern California, there is room to restore the approximate extent of historic wetlands, provide surrounding upland habitat to complete the ecosystem and accommodate sea level rise. When combined with the adjacent Mugu wetlands, it will be one of the largest wetland systems in Southern California. Currently public access is limited. This plan will create restoration alternatives and enhance public enjoyment of Ormond Beach.
