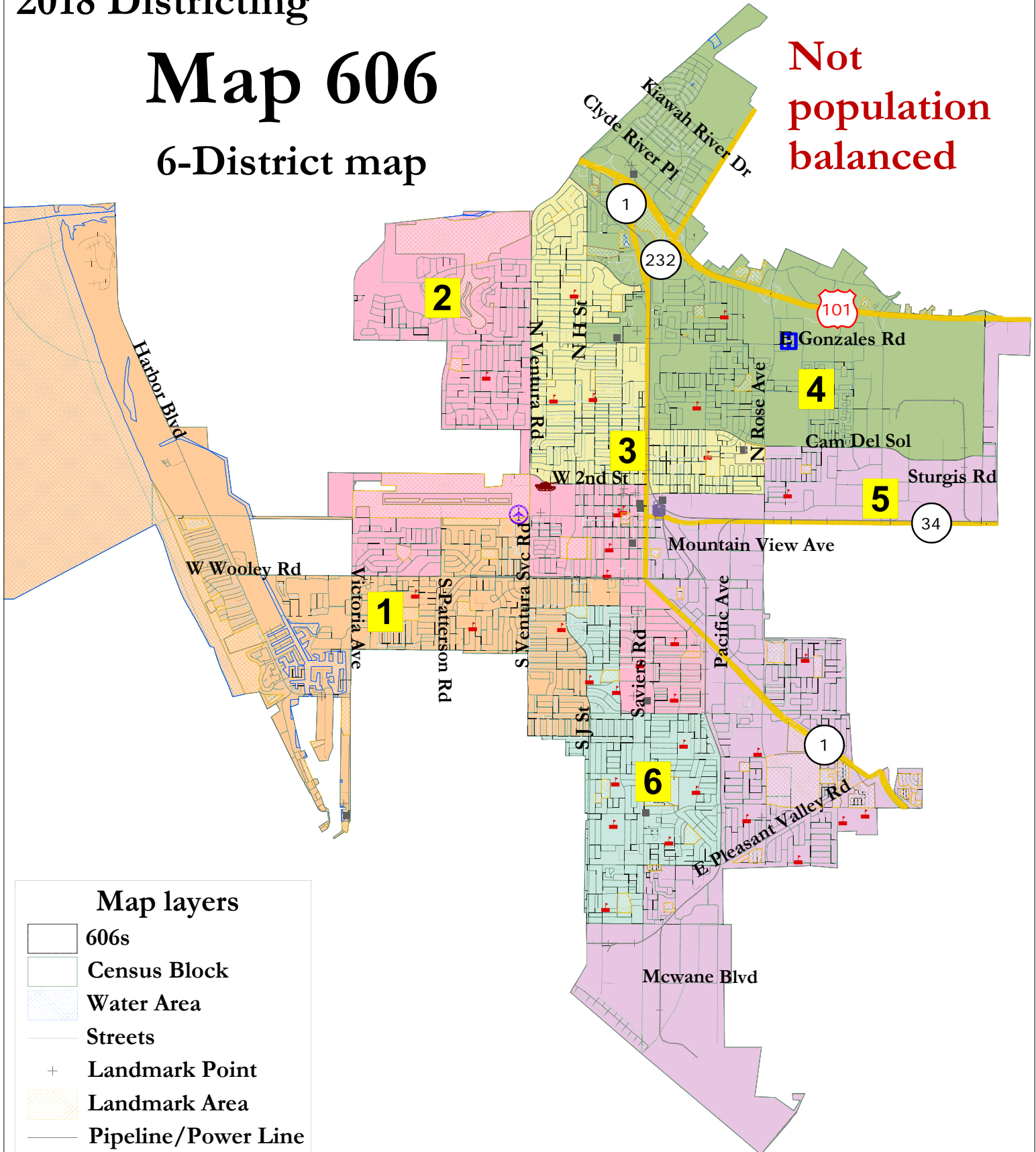


City of Oxnard 2018 Districting
