### **Re: Clean-up of the Oxnard Trail**

Beginning on Monday, July 8, 2019 at 8:30 AM the Special Districts Division will begin the systematic clean-up of the Oxnard Trail area between LMD 46 Daily Ranch on Camino Del Sol and the park located at the top of LMD 39 El Sueno Promesa/DR Horton on Entrada Drive.

### **Below is the anticipated schedule for clean-up and maintenance of the area:**

Monday, July 8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Oxnard Police Department sweep to evict the transients</li><li>• Work Release Crew supervised by staff to remove all trash from the Oxnard Trail</li><li>• Removal and maintenance of vegetation along the trail</li><li>• Installation of mulch on the slope to mitigate weeds</li></ul>
Tuesday, July 9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Continuation of the removal of vegetation and plant separation</li><li>• Installation of mulch on the slope to mitigate weeds</li></ul>
Wednesday, July 10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Continuation of work from previous day</li><li>• Special Districts staff to begin the knocking down of weeds and spreading of mulch along on the west side of the Oxnard Trail Fence</li></ul>
Thursday, July 11	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• City Corps crew to pressure wash sidewalks and amenities along the trail to remove excess dirt and any graffiti</li></ul>

### **Removal and Maintenance of vegetation includes but may not be limited to:**

- Removal of hedges at the top of the block wall at the top of the slope on the trail
- Installation of Creeping Fig climbing vine along the base of the wall in vacant areas to help deter from graffiti
- Separation and lowering of plant material along the Oxnard Trail fence to not allow vagrants to set up living accommodation or have the ability to hide

### **Pending Projects for the Oxnard Trail:**

Special Districts staff have been working diligently on the replacement of the Oxnard Trail lighting system. As of last week, staff met with Southern California Edison and an electrical engineer to finalize the plans for better power access for the new lighting system and the installation of Community Cameras in the area. Once we receive the completed and approved plans, we will be able to publish the Request for Bid on the project. Due to the old infrastructure on the trail, an extensive amount of work will need to be done to install a new lighting system. We anticipate this project going out to bid in August 2019 and breaking ground on the project before the end of the year. We appreciate the patience from the residents and look forward to completing this project in the near future. All work is subject to change. Please see our website for additional details.
