1903 CONCRETE BOLLARD

1903-1 SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of the Work shall consist of installing round concrete bollard anchored at the north end of the concrete boarding island on Bus Stop #20 per the Engineer's direction.

1903-2 MATERIALS

Dimensions: 24" diameter x 36" height (max.), with 1" tall x 1/2" deep reveal 6" down from top.

Weight: 440 lbs per 1' length

Materials: 3/8" steel rebar, Concrete for bollard shall conform to Section 201 of

the Standard Specifications and shall be Class 500-C-2500.

Stress Load: Not less than 4,500 PSI at 28 days

Finish: Medium sandblast

Color: Brown

1903-3 CONSTRUCTION

The concrete bollard shall be reinforced with rebar to ensure maximum strength and durability. Bollard shall be installed vertically square, with an above grade height of 36 inches. Bollard shall be anchored in concrete pad with a protruding 3" galvanized pipe.

1903-4 PAYMENT

Installation of concrete bollards shall be paid on a unit cost basis as shown in the Bid Sheet. Such payment shall be considered full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary to complete the Work in accordance with these specifications.
