

Below is the weekly remote sensor data from 6/3/21 to 6/9/21. Dissolved oxygen concentrations (DO; in blue) were generally acceptable at both stations. DO concentrations dropped to or below 4 mg/L during the night or early morning on a few days at both stations but concentrations recovered quickly later in the morning. Generally low concentrations of chlorophyll with normal daily oscillations (chlorophyll is a proxy for microscopic algal biomass, in green) were observed at both stations.

The City of Oxnard and Aquatic Bioassay & Consulting will continue to monitor the sensors in the area.
