The Commission also provides a representative to the County Continuum of Care Alliance. In addition, the Commission is represented on the City's review panel which evaluates applications for funding submitted to the City for various federal entitlement grant programs.			
Meeting Information:	The Commission on Homelessness meets the first Monday of each month from 4:00-5:30 p.m., and meetings are customarily held in the Oxnard City Council Chambers. Commission agendas are prepared and noticed on the City of Oxnard website in accordance with the City's Sunshine Ordinance.

COMMUNITY RELATIONS COMMISSION

Number of members and qualifications:	7 members. Members must reside in Oxnard and be at least 18 years old. They shall broadly represent the religious, racial and ethnic groups of the City
Term:	2 years
Purpose:	Appointed to identify and advise the City Council on problems of discrimination in the community and to promote better human relations among all city residents. The commissioners will analyze, define, and investigate community relations issues and needs in the City and advise City Council on matters involving group prejudices, racial tension, intolerance or differences in treatment or favoritism of persons on a basis other than individual merit
Meeting Information:	Third Monday of each month, except during January and February, when meetings take place on the fourth Monday of the month because of the holidays. The CRC also conducts an annual Strategic Planning Meeting (typically held in January). City Council, city staff members, community organizations and the general public, are invited to this meeting to provide the CRC with input, ideas and concerns regarding community related issues. Feedback from the Strategic Planning Meeting allows the CRC to schedule their monthly meetings with topics addressing the community on subject matters that pertain to the powers and duties of the CRC as listed in the bylaws.
