JUNIOR ACCESSORY DWELLING UNIT

DISCLAMER

Following Junior ADU requirements are for reference only and do not need to be included with ADU project submittal.

<u>REQUIREMENTS</u>	Check if Yes
1. Is the Junior ADU less than 500 square feet?	
2. Does the Junior ADU have a separate egress entrance?	
3. Does the Junior ADU have a cooking facility that meets the following minimum requirements?	
a. Eight (8) square feet of counter space.	
b. Five (5) linear feet of cabinetry.	
c. A sink with hot and cold water.	
d. A refrigerator with a minimum capacity of 4.5 cubic feet.	
e. Two (2) GFCI receptacles (outlets).	
4. Does the Junior ADU have Sanitation facilities (full bathroom)? Note: Junior ADU may share the sanitation facilities with the main residence.	
5. Will the Junior ADU be part of the main residence, existing or proposed (not a detached structure)? Note: An attached garage is considered part of the main residence, however, an existing attached garage must be converted to habitable space for the SFD (Single Family Residence) prior to being designated as a Junior ADU. Additionally, parking requirements must be met when an existing garage is converted to habitable space for the SFD. Contact the Planning Department for any questions concerning parking requirements.	

Additional Notes

- 1. Separate utilities (water, sewer, gas, and electric) are not required.
 - a. Justification for capacity of utilities (including the water heater first hour rating) are required as a part of the plans.
- 2. For fire and life safety regulations, a Junior ADU is not considered a separate unit.
