INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE NOTICE OF PROPOSED FILMING FORM

FILMING LOCATION: Identify the address of filming. Separate locations require a

separate Notice of Proposed Filming for each location.

Example: 300 W C Street

DATE(S) AND TIMES: Include the day(s), date(s), and times of filming at the location.

Example: Tuesday, March 8, 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Wednesday, March 9, 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

PARKING: Include the number of vehicles needed for the filming and explain where

they will be parked (off-site, in the street), etc. If temporary "No Parking"

signs or street closures are proposed, include that information.

Example: Ten cars will be parked in the parking structure at 328 S. B

Street. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted in three street parking spaces on the street in front of 300 W. C Street and in five parking spaces in the parking lot behind the

building. No street closures are proposed.

OUTDOOR LIGHTING: Identify any outdoor lighting that may affect neighboring properties. If

no outdoor lighting is proposed, state that. Do not leave this field blank.

Example: No outdoor lighting is proposed.

EXTERIOR NOISE: Identify any exterior sources of noise that may affect

neighboring properties. If no exterior sources of noise are

proposed, state that. Do not leave this field blank.

Example: A generator will be running intermittently during filming, but

it will be turned off no later than 3:00 p.m. Exterior dialogue will be recorded but will not affect adjacent properties.









NOTICE OF PROPOSED FILMING

The City of Oxnard requires filmmakers to notify surrounding residents and businesses of any proposed filming activities that may affect neighboring properties. A description of the activities proposed in your neighborhood is shown below.
